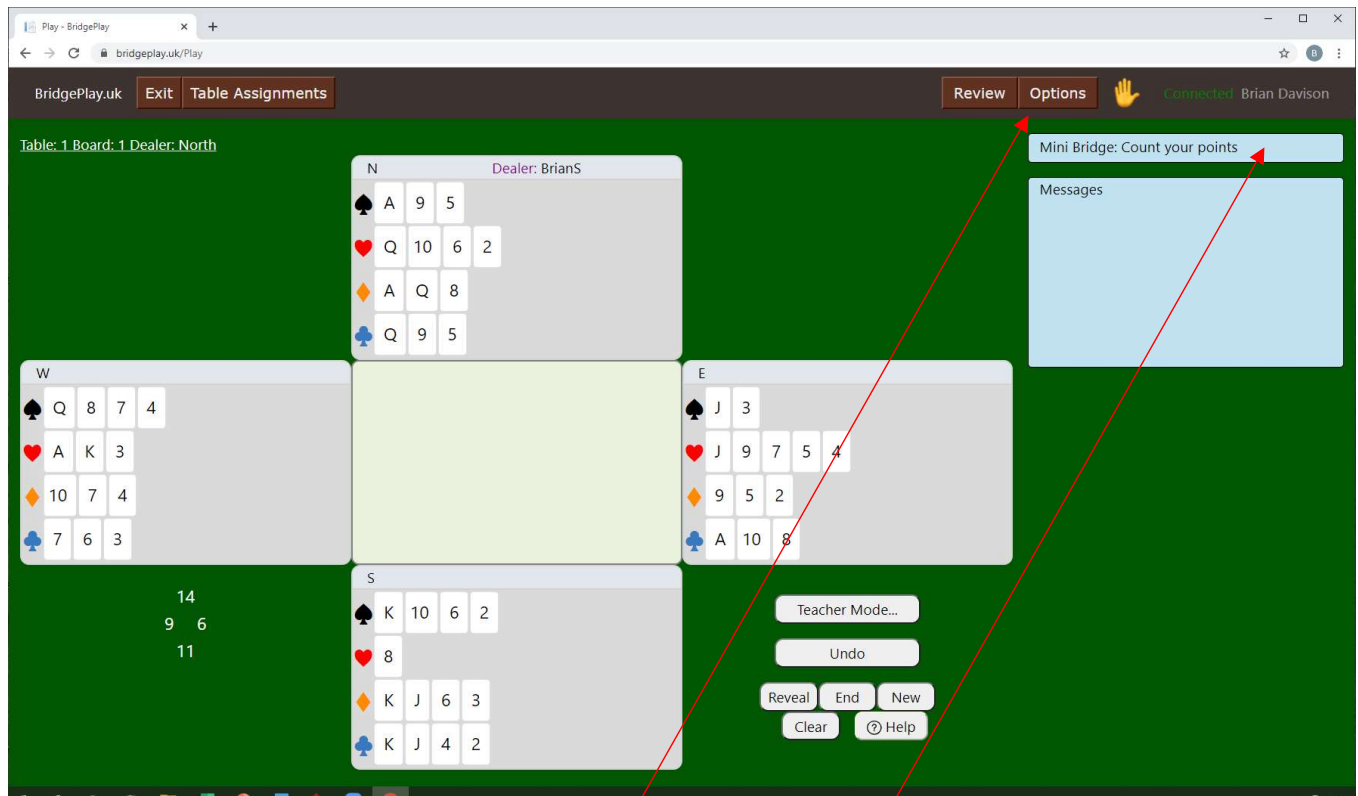


Supervising MiniBridge In Bridgeplay.uk

This is the Supervisor's view



If no cards are displayed yet – select <Options> and then <New Board>

In the top right of the screen, it will then say "Mini Bridge: Count your points"

At this point, the students will be able to see only their own hand.

Counting & Announcing Points

Starting with the dealer, and then in clockwise order, request each player to announce how many points his or her hand contains.

Ace	:	4
King	:	3
Queen	:	2
Jack	:	1

Deciding The Declaring And Defending Sides

The partnership with the most points becomes the declaring side who decide the contract.

The other pair are the defending side, who try to prevent the contract being made by making tricks themselves.

There is a re-deal if the point distribution between the partnerships turns out to be 20 : 20.

Deciding The Declarer

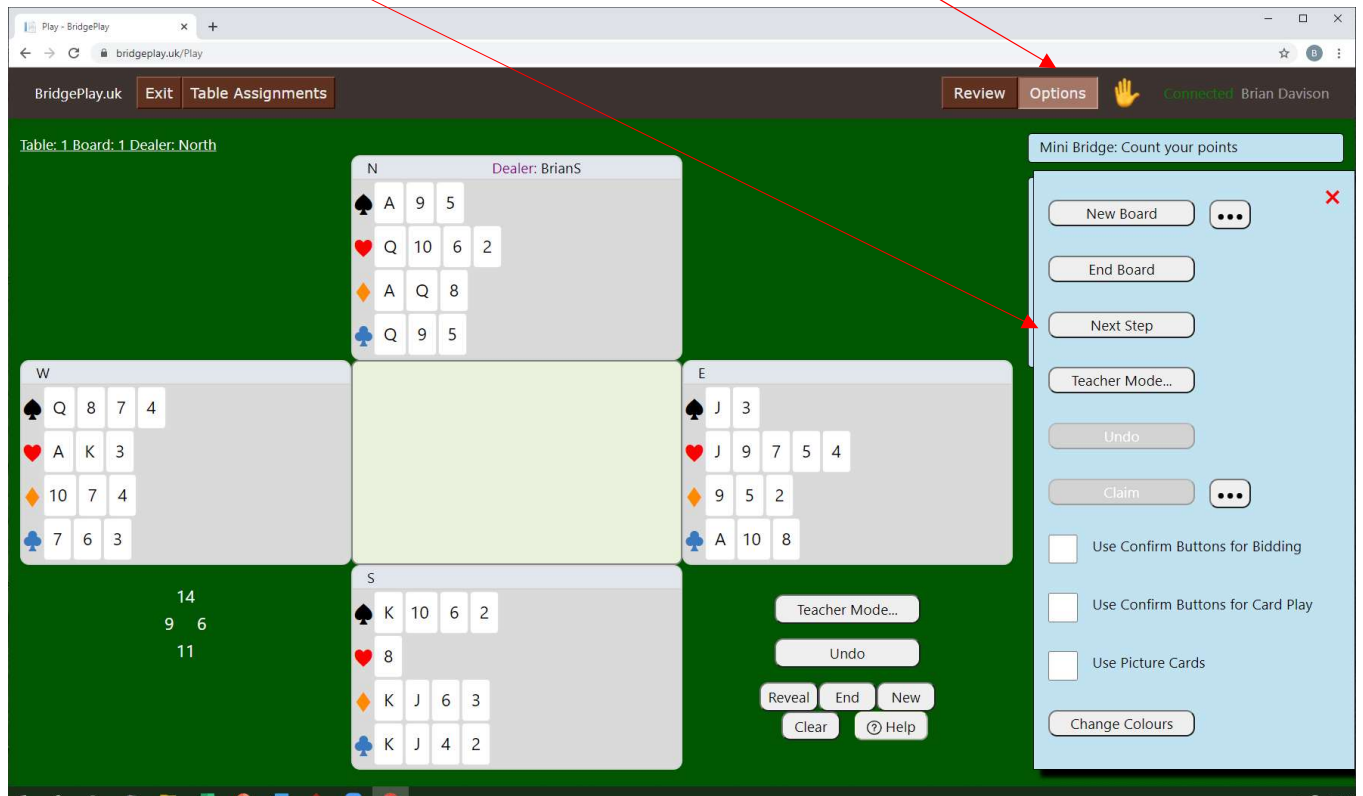
The player with the higher number of points in the declaring side becomes 'declarer'.

Their partner becomes 'dummy'.

If they both have the same number of points, the player who announced points first is declarer.

The supervisor clicks on < Options > to get the drop down box shown.

Then click on < Next Step >



After <Next Step>

The supervisor will see “Mini Bridge: Showing dummy” in the top right status box.

The students will all see the appearance of the Dummy hand.

At this point, discuss with the student, how many tricks do they think they can make.

When ready to move on, select <Next Step> again.

The supervisor will see “Mini Bridge: Select contract” in the top right status box.

The student declarer will see the contract selection box.

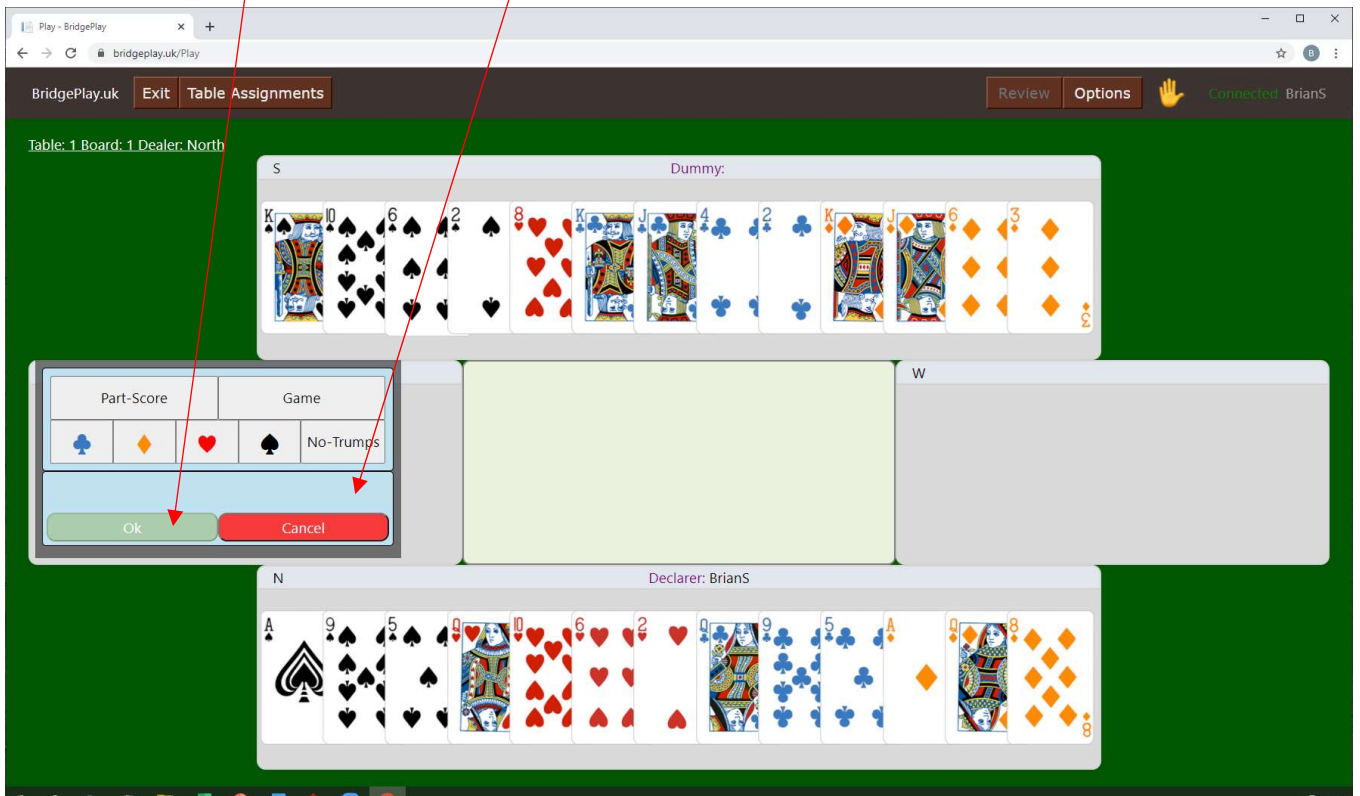
Declarer must decide whether to:

Play in game or part score

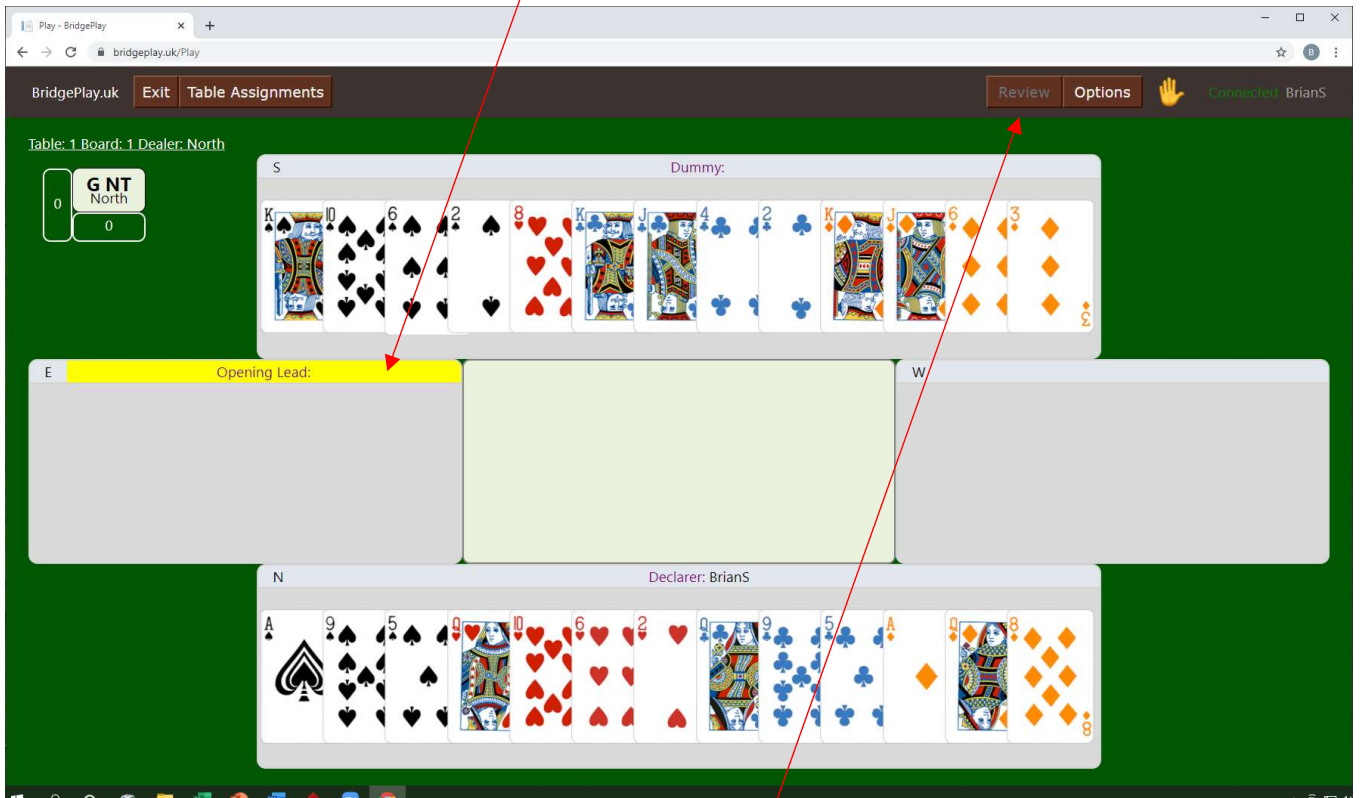
No Trumps or a suit contract

They select appropriate options using this box ...

...and then click OK



The player to make the opening lead is now highlighted.
This player makes the opening lead and play continues normally.



At any point during the play the supervisor can view the “Review File”
Players can click on it to see it only at the end of the play.
The supervisor can use it for pointers for discussion at the end of the play.

At the end of play, all hands are revealed.

When discussion is complete the supervisor clicks on < Options > to select < New Board >
